### **Proposal for Establishing 'Civilization Peace Corps' establishing a new type of Peace Corps.**

*AmeriCorps* and *The Peace Corps* provide the *starter kits* for many countries that includes well digging, animals for food sources, teachers for instructing in hopes a country can take a the first start to getting a civilization established to a better life style for people to be able to survive and house each other the better way of life.

When that happens in order for a jump to one economic station state to happen an extra boost is needed but is not always the same for everybody and should not always be the same for everybody to keep a free enterprise happening. Call it a *paradox*<sup>1</sup> that can work. Also, this includes the transitional jump of staying at a certain economic station state that had been achieved by a person or family. 'Civilization Peace Corps' is to be used as a preventative for a backward movement to a lower economic station state – those that own homes, cars, etc. (A preventative to not have to sell ownership of property i.e. home should not have to be sold to live in assisted living or nursing home).

***SECTION I : Explanation for Healthcare, Retirement and Home Owners.***

Those requesting the ‘Civilization Peace Corps’ volunteers for service may sign up for more than one volunteer i.e.<sup>2</sup> helping elderly stay in the home includes agriculture (lawn care etc.)

Those volunteering for service will be on a rotation period of a two year sign up in other states including Alaska and Hawaii. Bus tickets including flight tickets to off land states (Hawaii and Alaska to be funded by transportation companies) and government programs along with non-profit organizations are need to make the program work. Workers as Volunteers will not be able to look for additional work until the 2 year rotation period is up. They will travel to different states. Compensation will be housing at the person that request the volunteer or a person in the town housing in family setting, NO Shelters are to be used for this or these program(s) in ‘Civilization Peace Corps’ (Shelters are programs for different purpose) food stamps, medicare for insurance (government insurance card), a small donated gift amount for toiletries and an emergency card will be sent and set- up and activated at a 24 hour service center in case of emergency that includes family death and need for a leave of absence happens. Volunteers can use their service as part of their internships if required by a school. i.e.<sup>2</sup> Trade school(s) will have apprenticeship opportunities with farmers, automotive small shops to large. All volunteers will be shipped in from other states and interchange of exchange will happen. Volunteers will not stay in the same state they signed up in or lived in. Volunteers have the option of choice in what states they would like to go to. Background checks on volunteers and those looking for volunteers to assist them would be for the protection of both parties involved. Gifts of donations directly to the volunteers should fill out a Civilization Peace Corps donation notification slip of notification. If a personal gift of donation to a volunteer is offered by a person/party receiving the volunteer service they are to please notify the Civilization Peace Corps for the protection of all three parties involved so there are No misunderstanding of acceptance or terms received involving all parties involved.

Draft for those that own homes, property (especially elders that are retired) – All qualify.

Home Health Care Volunteers – Keeping the retired in homes and enjoying life.

#### ***The OUTLINE for VOLUNTEERS for the SERVICE:***


***Volunteers should know that this is a service to those that put in their lives of service into companies that existed to help others through whatever professions they held during their life time or times so that others will also have a better life.***


 *Volunteers for Service in 'Civilization Peace Corps'*

 *Volunteers are required to have education in the areas applied to that include trade schools from high school, independent trade schools and/or college and/or class verification of study (Volunteers will qualify for apprentice work out of state but not in neighboring states for apprentice work)*

 *2 Year Sign-Up Rotation in other states including Alaska and Hawaii*  
*Bus tickets including tickets off land states issued to Volunteers*  
*Tickets to be funded by transportation companies using government and non government funding Volunteers will not stay in the same state they signed up in or lived in. Volunteers have the option of choice in what states they would like to go as long as they are not neighboring states or states they have lived in or signed up in.*  
*NO Interviewing for employment until 2 year rotation contract has expired with both parties Volunteer and 'Civilization Peace Corps'. End of 2 year rotation for Volunteer expired contract options for other programs to assist in employment are referred to employment agencies upon return of state that Volunteer signed contract at 2 year end. Or the option of certification for internships to continue schooling for chosen profession credit listed and transferred to the chosen institute of the Volunteer by certify mail and email.*  
*Those working with small businesses to get them started will rotate more often in the states during the 2 year rotation than other program(s) depending on what is being accomplished.*

 *Volunteer Background check and drug screening.*

 *Housing for Volunteers will NOT be using shelters but local volunteer families in a family setting or with those that qualify and use the service. The barter agreement of service in exchange for a bed is with the family or home owner or Volunteer family or homeowner to assist in a bed (Shelters are designed for a different need in the social order)*

 *Food will be at NO Expense to the Volunteer or the person requesting the Volunteer but will be referred to government food cards and non government food banks.*

 *Insurance card for Health issued from the government to cover the two year rotation (only).*

 *24 Hour Emergency Card activation card will be given to the Volunteers upon assignment will 24 Emergency number to get a Volunteer back to their home or location where a family emergency has taken place. Cell number should be provided to the service for a 24 hour after care give to make sure Volunteer arrives at location along with a check up/follow up number for the Civilization Peace Corps to find out if you will be returning back to the location of service.*

 *24 Hour Emergency Center will dispatch for a replacement Volunteer.*


 *Extra expenses, of toiletries are funded through donations, personal, business etc.*


 *Personal Gifts or Donations need to be recorded for the protection of 'Civilization Peace Corps' the Volunteer for Service and the Receiver of the Service.*

#### **(Property Owners)**


 *Home owner retired that does not want to sell to go to assisted living.*


 *Home owner retired that does not have the time or able to do the gardening.*


 *Home owner retired that does not have funds to buy a car. Home bound*

 *Home owner retired that needs additional help in planting the gardens due to age or needs an apprentice.*

 *Home owner retired that needs house cleaning.*

 *Home owner retired that needs office assistance in paying the bills. All they have to do is sign or type the billing papers up for the owner.*

 *Home owner retired that needs a CNA to stop by or live with them. (Remember this program does not take away from paid professions – these are newly CNA or those that would like to assist others and took the time to volunteer)*

 *Home owner - a person in the family volunteers may request a volunteer to help out while the family member participates. This way the family member will be able to return to family home business family home caring of others in another family until they return. Giving that family member the opportunity to follow his schooling of agriculture, automotive, horticulture, office assistance, etc thought the exchange can be for a different return that the volunteer in family*
