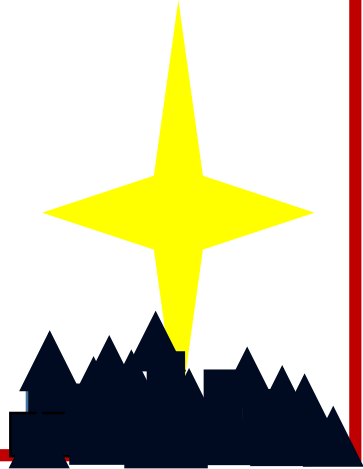

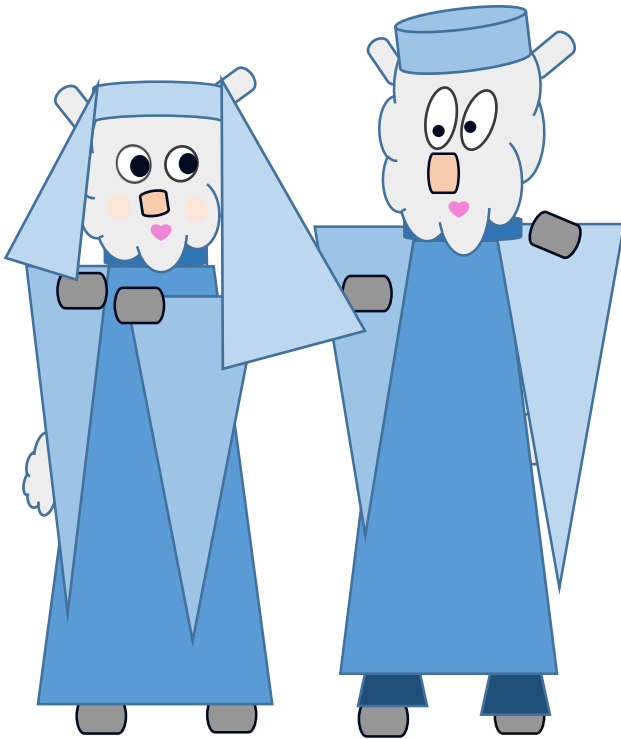

he shall save his people from their sins.



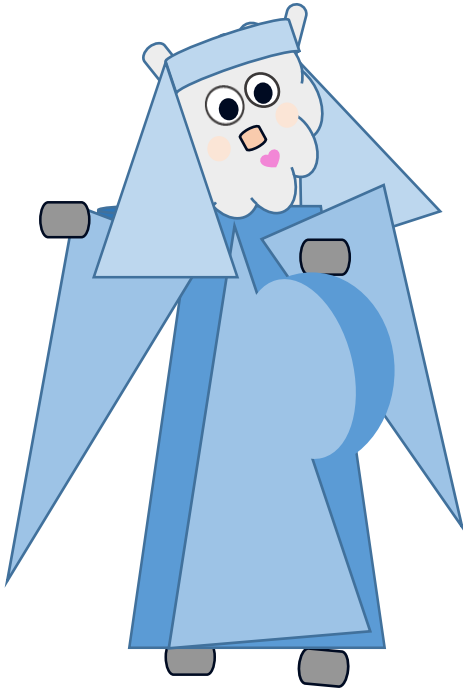
“Let’s put on a play about the baby Jesus,” the sheep said as they put their Holy Bible on the table.



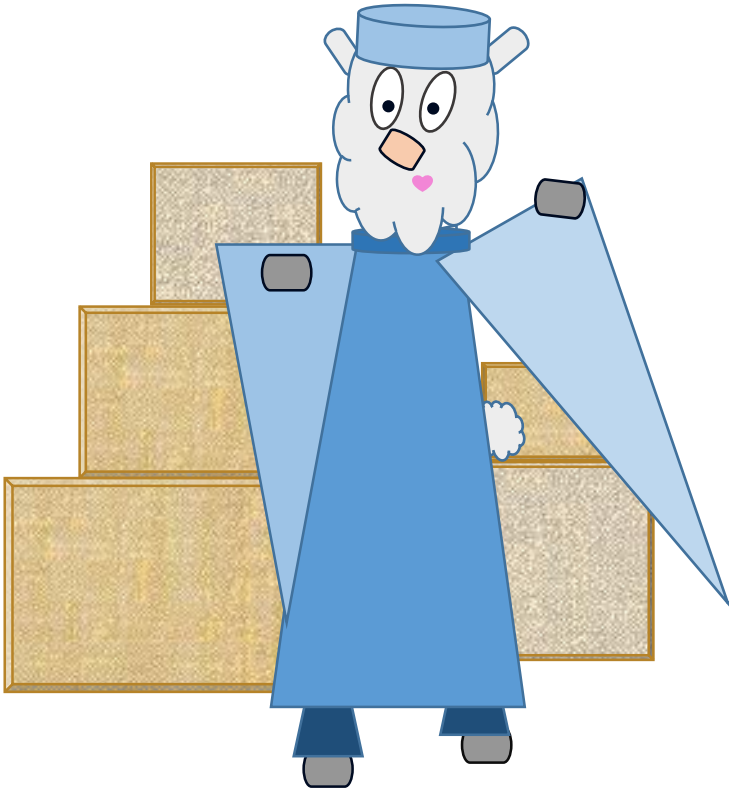
The two sheep decided to dress up as Mary and Joseph. The mom and dad in the story about the baby Jesus.



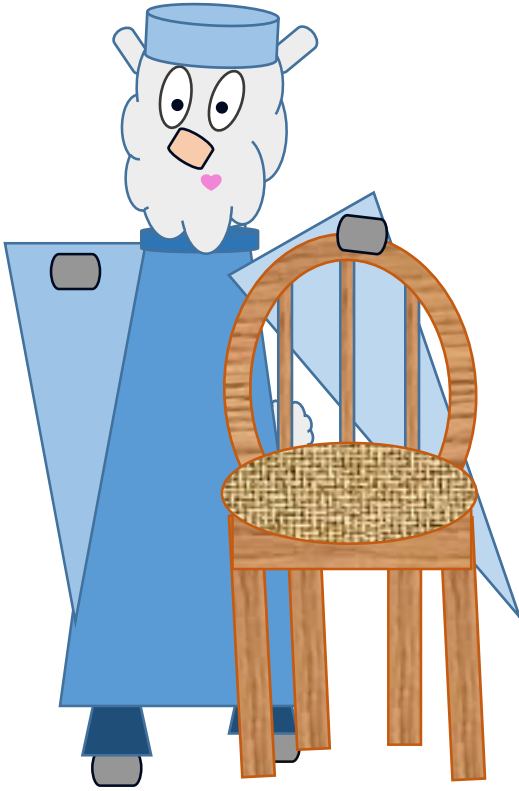
“I’m going to put a pillow under my costume to pretend it’s baby Jesus,” said the sheep dressed up like Mary.



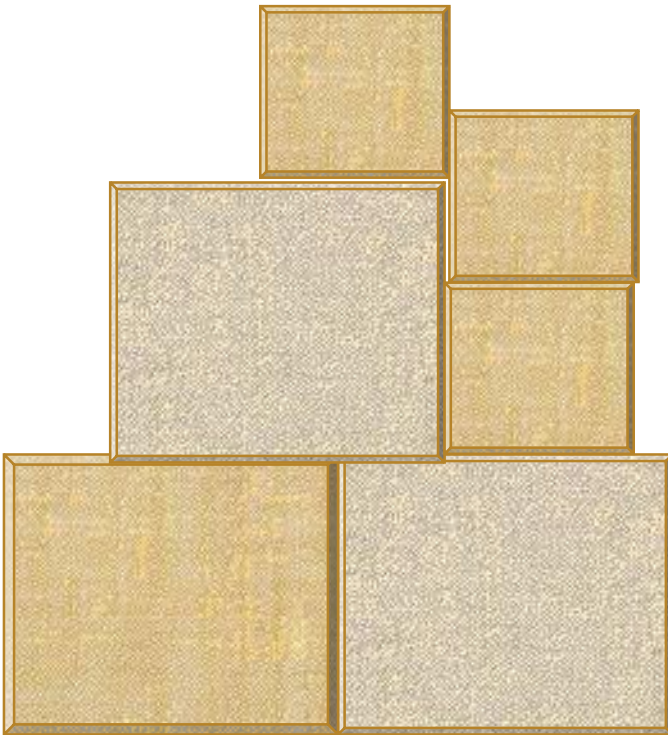
“Look!” “Now my tummy sticks way out,” said Mary.



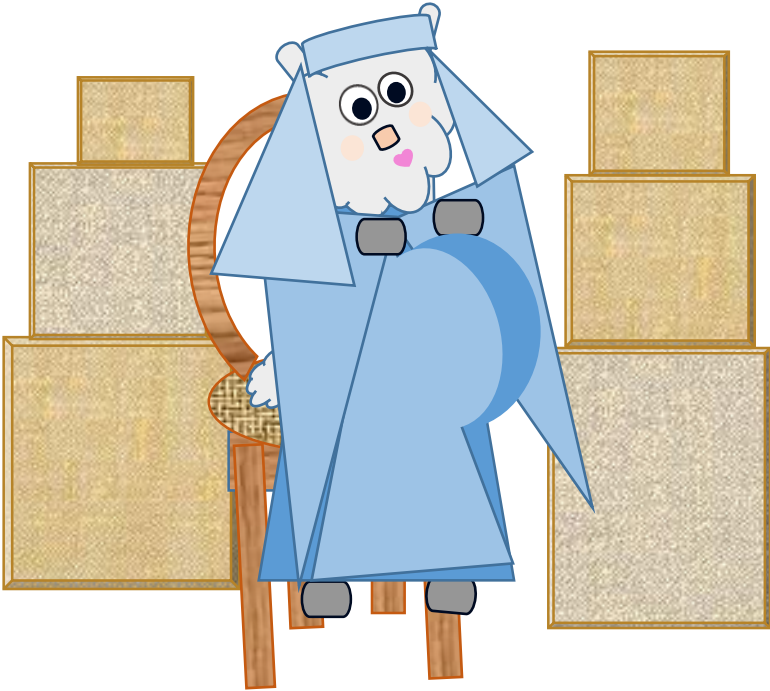
“Mary, we are to travel to a city called Bethlehem.” “That is the city of David,” said Joseph.



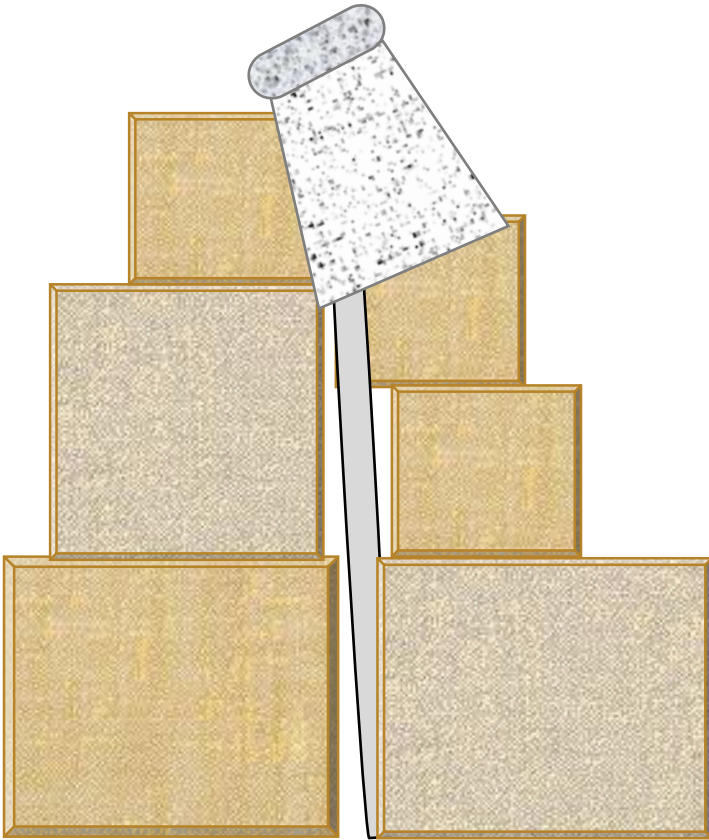
“Mary, sit on this chair.” “We will pretend its our donkey.” “The donkey will take us to Bethlehem,” said Joseph.



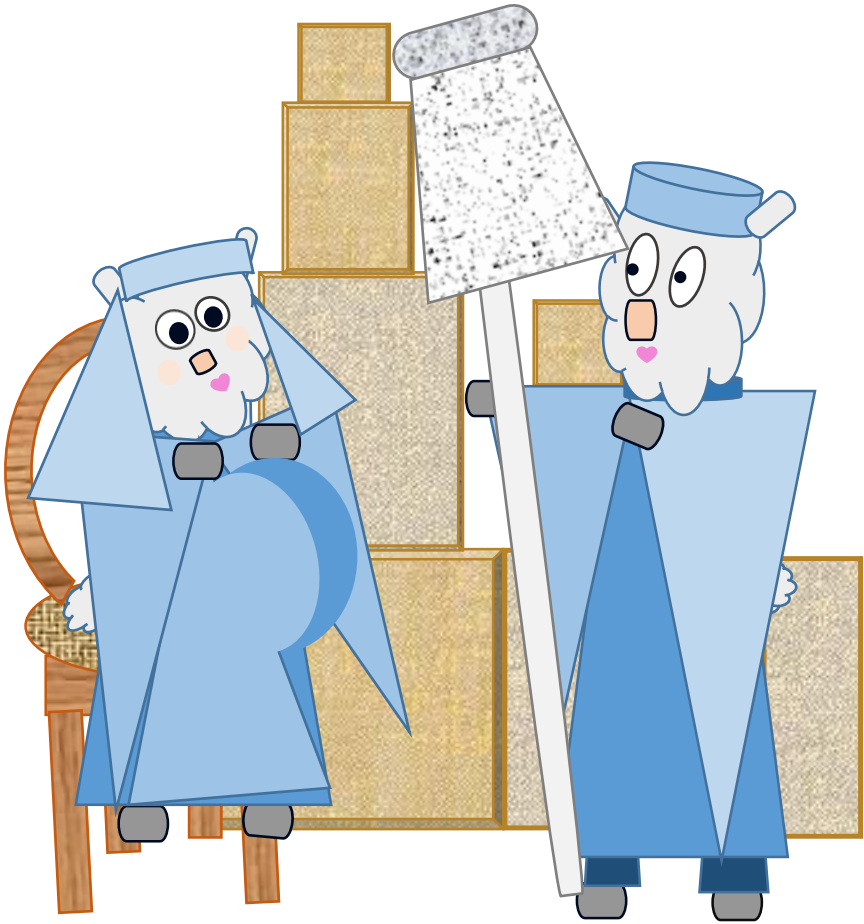
“Look Mary, I took boxes and

said Joseph.



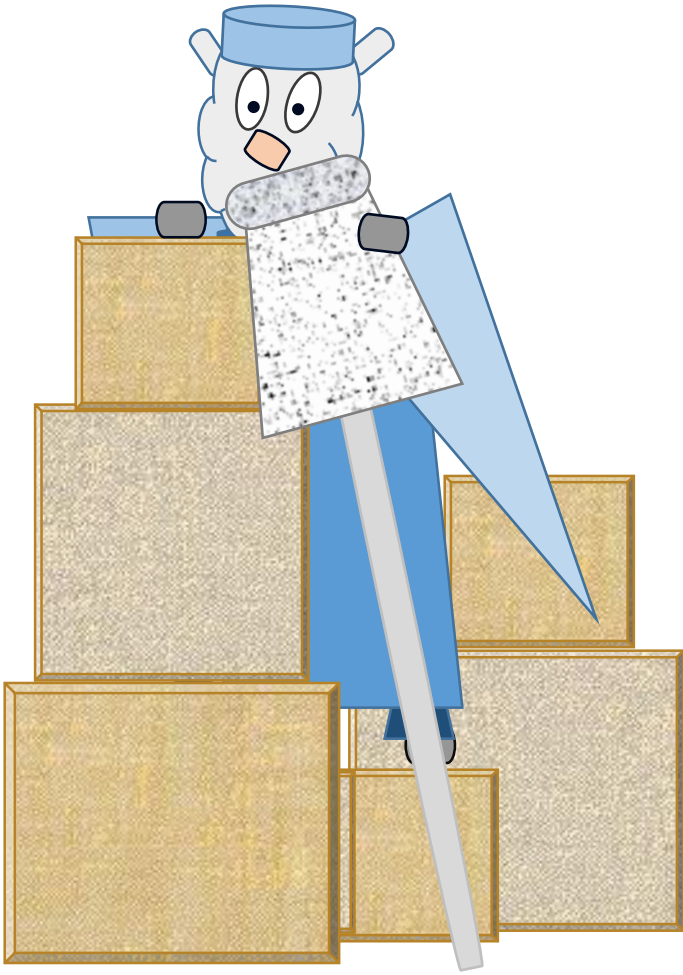
“Where shall we sleep all the Inns are full Joseph?” asked Mary on her chair donkey.



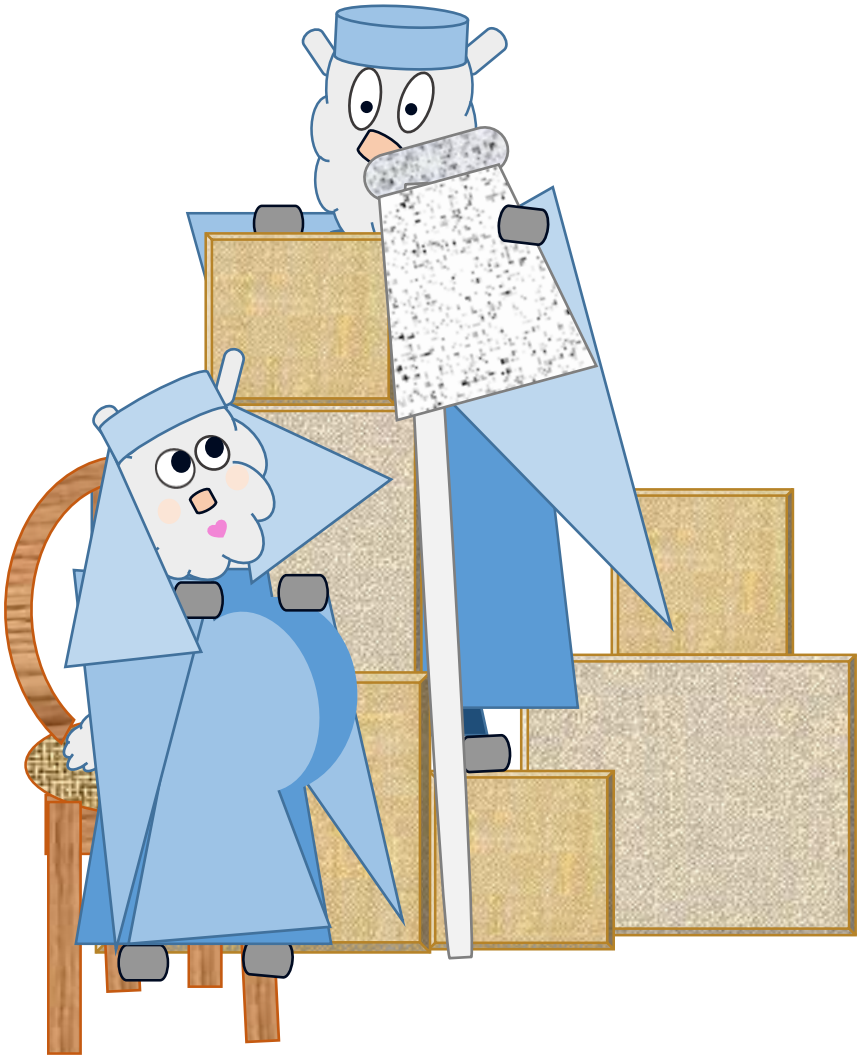
“Mary, lets ask an Inn keeper.”

keeper, ” said Joseph.



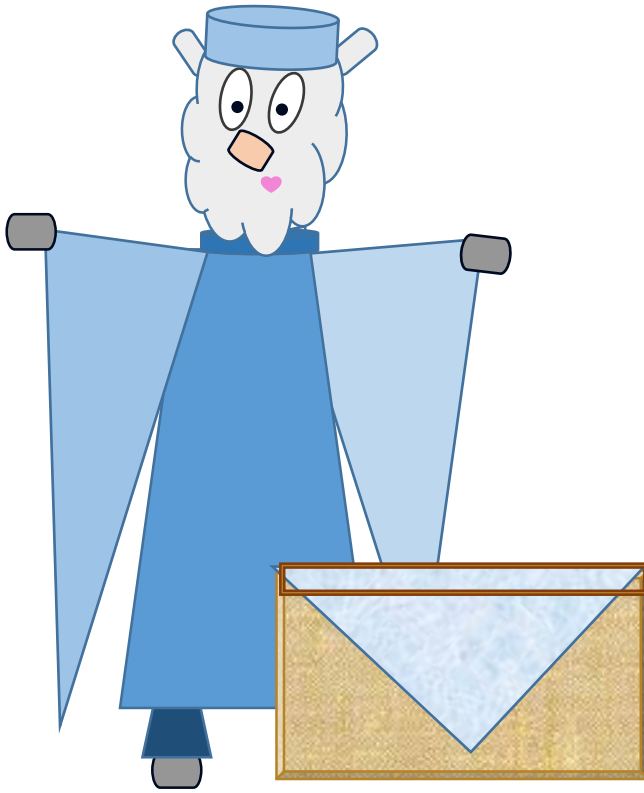
“Inn keeper do you have room for me and my wife?” “She is about to have a baby,” Joseph asked the Inn keeper mop.



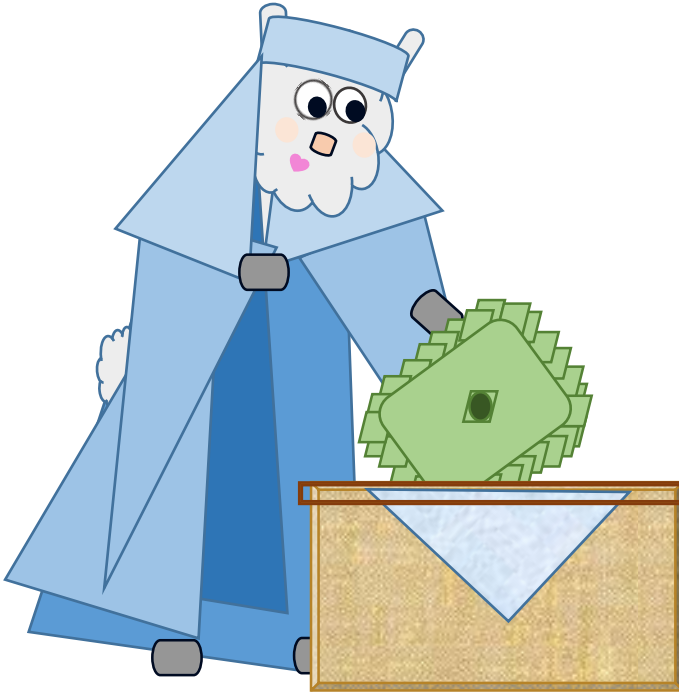
“There is no room in the Inn.”

“Thank you,” responded Mary to the sheep acting as the Inn keeper.



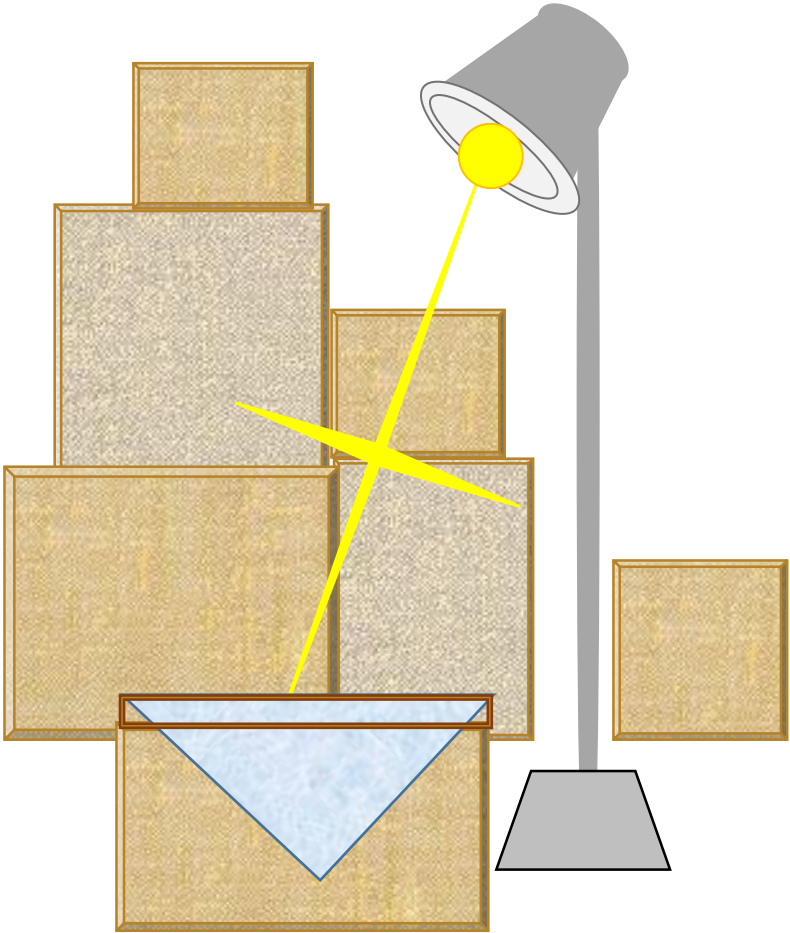
“Look Mary, I made a manger bed for the baby Jesus,” said Joseph.



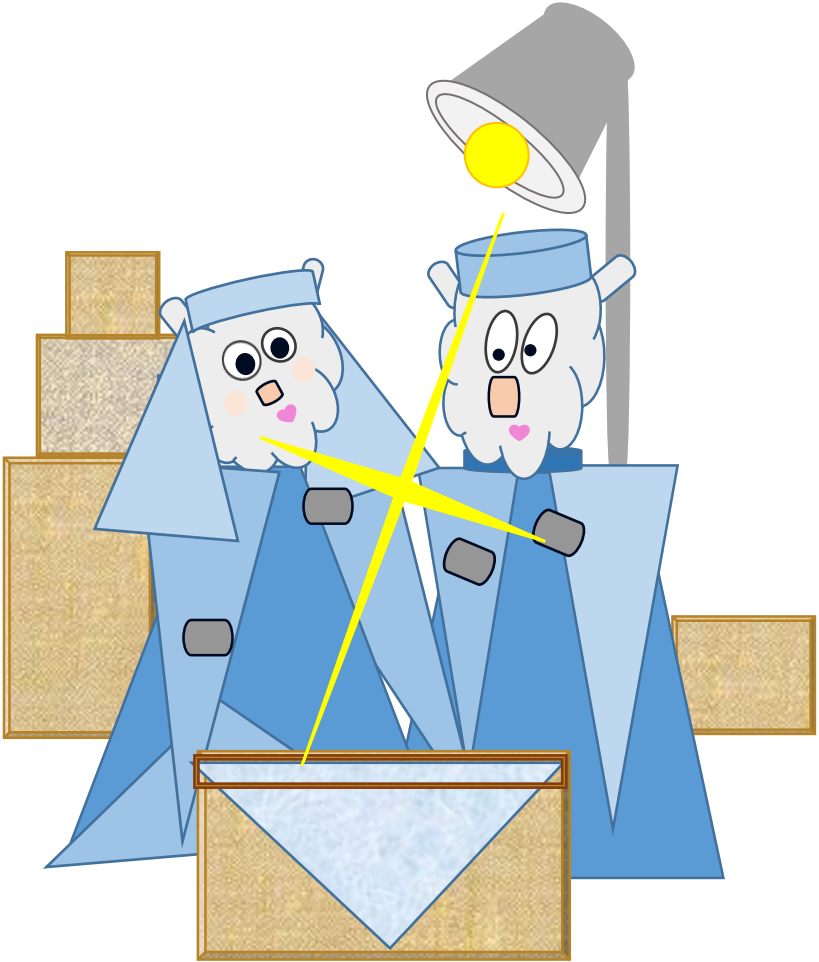
“Joseph while you made the manger for his bed, I had baby Jesus,” Mary said as she pulled out the pillow from under her costume and put the pillow in the manger.



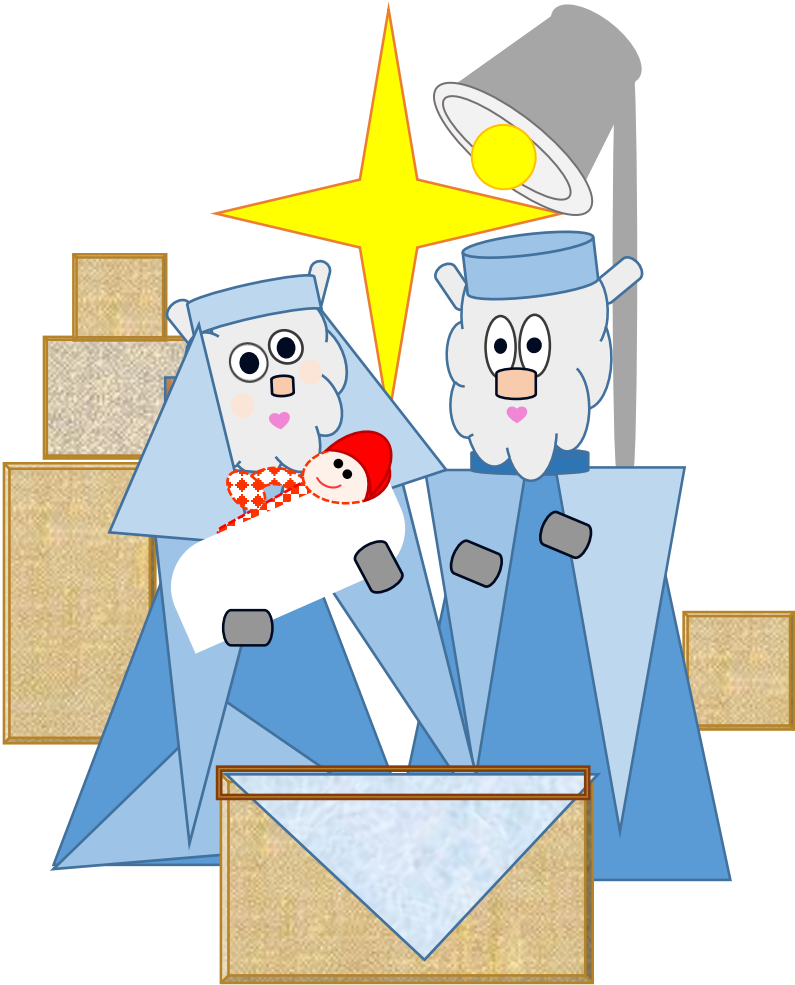
Joseph took out the pillow and put a doll in the manger. “Look Mary, the doll can be the baby Jesus,” said Joseph.



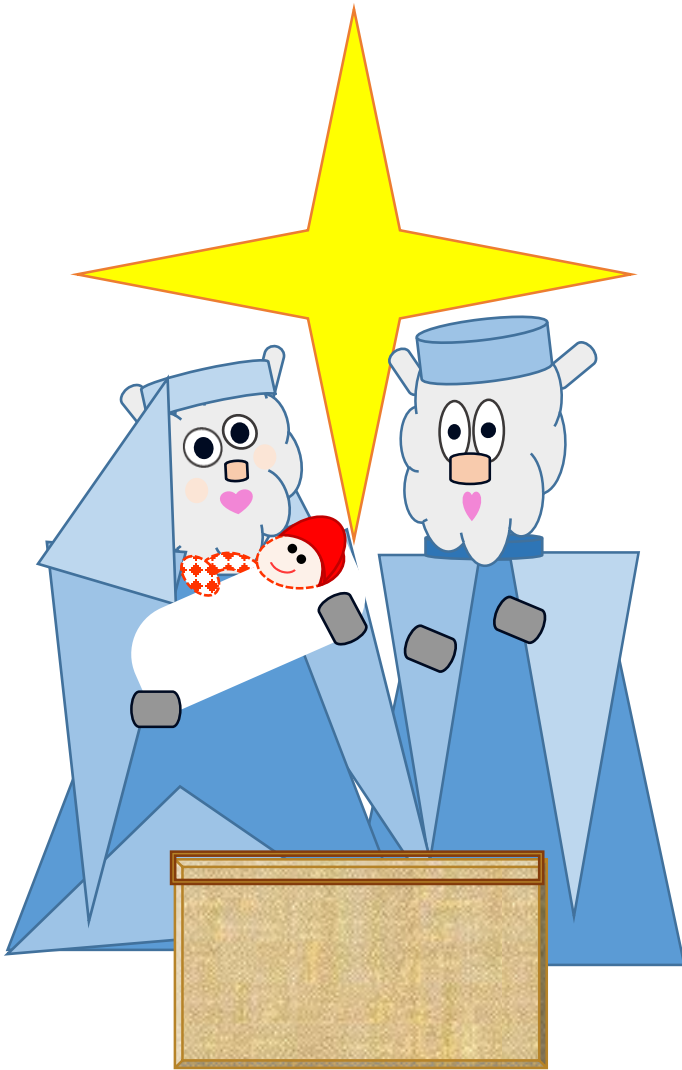
Mary put the lamp by the manger.



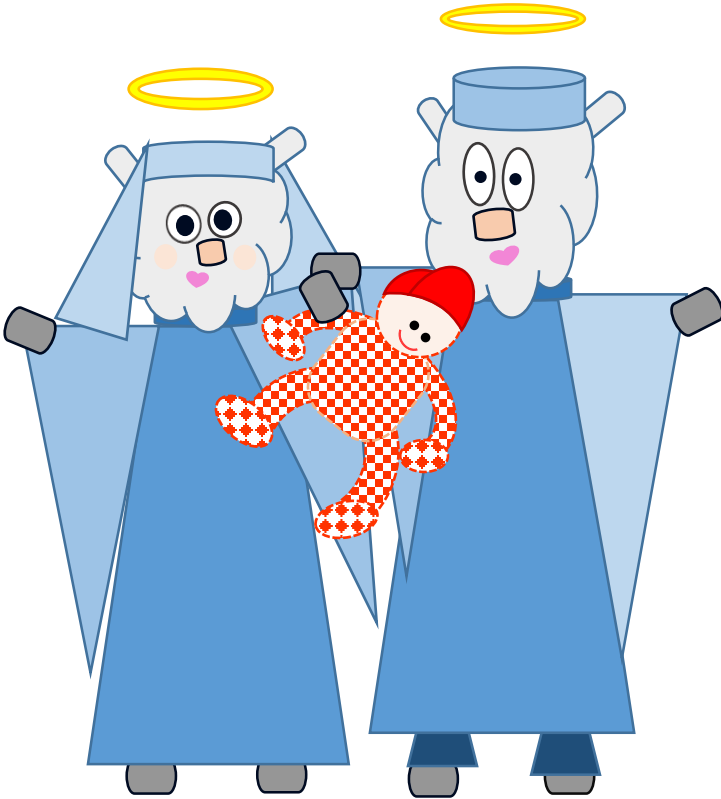
“Look Joseph the lamp makes a really bright star above the manger,” Mary said.

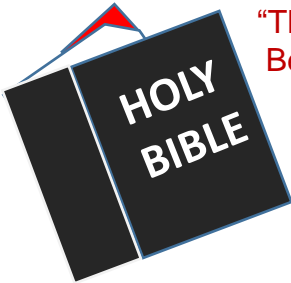
