
Directions for making the flash cards. 'What Insect Am I?'

Butterfly - a kind of insect that has a long thin body and brightly colored wings and that flies mostly during the day

Caterpillar – a small creature that is like a worm with many legs and that changes to become a butterfly or moth

Chrysalis- a hard case that protects a moth or butterfly while it is turning into an adult

Metamorphosis- a major change in the form or structure of some animals or insects that happens as the animal or insect becomes an adult

Nectar – a thick juice made from a particular fruit or a sweet liquid produced by plants





I am special that I can attach myself to a branch and make my own sleeping bag called a chrysalis. I go to sleep for many days.


